

TUITION WAIVER – STUDENTS LEAVING DISTRICT

If a student leaves the district prior to the start of 3rd trimester, the parents may submit a request in writing to the school board if they desire to have the student remain in the school district for the remainder of the school year. If the board approves, the parents will be liable for the prorated tuition payment to the school district, the amount to be determined by the number of days remaining in the school year. The best interests of both the school and the student shall be considered.

If a student moves from the district during the last trimester of the year, the administration shall decide whether or not it would be in the best interest of the student and/or the school for the student to remain for the balance of the year and no tuition will be charged.

In any case, the student's continued presence in the school and his/her tuition status will be contingent on his/her behavior and department.
